2. What is one initiative that you would personally like to start at your local neighborhood or community level? What support will you need, and who can you enlist to help you? How would you measure the success of your initiative?

Being a student of Computer Systems Engineering in one of the most renowned University in Pakistan and after learning new skills through this exchange program, I aim to use my knowledge and skills to enhance the educational system of the government schools by selecting one of them as a 'Model School'. I propose to equip that model school with the contemporary technological facilities by installing a fully equipped computer laboratory and offering to impart my knowledge and skills to the students as well. This will certainly enable the students to connect with the world and will offer them new opportunities of learning. For example, it can help them in global learning through online tutorials, enhance their mathematical or science skills through technologies of digital simulations and modeling and can also help teachers in more efficient and computerized assessments of the students.

To initiate this project, I would require full support from the Government Education Department and partial support from an International NGO. I would prefer to propose this project and work closely with UNICEF or Save the children to implement this. I would also like to make a team of likeminded fellows to make it a success.

For measuring its results, I would do a comparative or assessment study after a year, between the students of the Model School and other government schools to analyze the impact of the project. This study may contain methods including surveys, semi-structured interviews or Focus Group Discussions with the students and teachers.

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
